Brighton Secondary School is committed to ensuring all International students have access to the necessary technology to support their learning. This policy outlines the device requirements and borrowing options available to students in the Study Abroad and Graduate Programs.

Study Abroad Program

Study Abroad Program students enrolled for a period ranging from one term to one year will loan a school device for the duration of their enrolment at no cost.

Families are required to sign a Digital Learning Policy – User Agreement & Payment form upon enrolment which outlines that any costs arising due to loss or damage to loan devices will be incurred by the student.

Graduate Program

Graduate Program students enrolled for the duration of their secondary schooling to achieve their South Australian Certificate of Education (SACE) are required to purchase their own device directly through the school's provider, for a once-off cost of approximately \$1600.

Accidental Damage Protection (ADP) for 3 years is included in the cost of the device, along with a 3-year manufacturer's warranty. ADP claims have an excess of \$110 per claim.

Compliance

International students are not permitted to bring their own device to use for their learning. This is to ensure students have appropriate devices that integrate with the South Australian Department for Education's systems and have access to the full range of IT support services at school.

Purchasing the school's preferred provider also allows families to access a discounted price.
