Brighton Secondary School (BSS) provides students in our International Student Program (ISP) with a study program that meets their individual needs as well as providing the support necessary for them to be successful.

### Full Fee Paying International Students

#### Programs Offered

For students age appropriate for Year 10, 11, and 12 only

- Graduate Program: Students studying to gain their South Australian Certificate of Education (SACE)
- Study Abroad Program (SAP): For a period of at least 10 weeks

#### Support and Resources Provided by Brighton Secondary School

The fees paid to International Education Services (IES) by ISP students cover enrolment at this school, as well as several administrative costs:

- Access to a wide curriculum, including Australian Curriculum and SACE subjects
- A tailored ISP induction and orientation program, including a copy of the BSS International Student Handbook
- Access to a wide range of language subjects by negotiation, and payment of language course fees for SACE students studying Background Speakers Language as part of their full-time load
- A pastoral care program supporting wellbeing, social and emotional skills
- Payment of subject course fees as outlined in the BSS Curriculum Guide on our website
- Payment of curriculum related camps, excursions, and incursions
- Holistic subject and career counselling to support SACE completion and eligibility for tertiary study
- Access to loan textbooks & calculators for all SAP students
- Access to stationery for subjects as required
- A student identification (ID) card each year of enrolment
- Access to the school network, internet, and cloud-based storage in alignment with the BSS Digital Learning Policy
- \$10 AUD for printing purposes via the student curriculum network upon enrolment
- A lock and locker for storage of school bags and valuables while at school
- Access to regular assessment and reporting documentation
- Access to wellbeing support
- Homestay family support
- Tickets to the Valedictory Presentation Evening for graduating students and two guests
- Payment of knockout and zone sport competition fees



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### Technology and Device Expectations

**Graduate Program Students:** Must purchase a Windows device through the school in accordance with the school's Digital Learning Policy. Privately supplied computers cannot be supported through the school network.

**SAP Students:** Will borrow a Windows device for the length of their program. Fees and payment information are outlined in the ISP Device Policy document available on our website. Devices remain the property of Brighton Secondary School until payment is made in full. Students and families must sign and return a Digital Learning Policy User Agreement – International.

**Laptop Repairs:** In the event of any damage, it is the students' responsibility to pay any repair costs not covered by the device's warranty. All repairs will be organised by the BSS ICT department. The school highly recommends students purchase 3-year accidental damage cover from an insurer of choice.

International students will be charged for any resources or equipment borrowed from the school and not returned in good condition (e.g., textbooks, laptops, calculators, musical instruments, sports uniforms).
