The Brighton Secondary School (BSS) Uniform Policy has been developed and approved by the school community through the Governing Council. The school expects the support and co-operation of all students, parents and staff in the implementation of the policy.

Rationale

All students are expected to wear the Brighton Secondary School uniform all day, every day with pride.

Wearing the uniform:

- Fosters a strong sense of connection and identity within the school community
- Promotes a positive image of the school to the wider community
- Supports student safety through easy identification on and off campus
- Ensures students are appropriately dressed for the full range of school activities
- Encourages equality among students by reducing peer pressure related to clothing
- Provides a cost-effective, durable alternative to everyday clothing choices.

Dress Code

Regular School Uniform

Students are provided with a range of options in the regular school uniform as listed on page 2 and pictured on Page 3. Students should wear uniform items that are appropriate for the weather and scheduled lessons on any given day, and that suit their individual needs and preferences. Regular school uniform should be worn at all school events and excursions, including before and after school commitments, unless otherwise specified.

Physical Education (PE) and Special Interest Volleyball (SIV) School Uniforms

Students may wear their PE or SIV uniform for the entire school day when they have a scheduled PE or SIV lesson. These uniforms are listed on Page 2 and pictured on Page 4 and are designed to support freedom of movement in keeping with the physical nature of these activities.

- Appropriate footwear, such as sneakers, must be worn as part of the PE/SIV uniform
- School jumpers or jackets may be worn over the top for added warmth.

General uniform expectations

- Students must wear either full Regular School Uniform or full PE/SIV Uniform and cannot mix items from both uniforms
- Students must wear enclosed school shoes (not sandals or slides) for practical subjects including Music, Science, and Technologies subjects
- Jewellery, piercings, and make-up should be discreet
- On “non-uniform” days, students are expected to wear clothing and footwear that appropriately covers the body, allows for freedom of movement, and ensures comfort and safety for all school activities
- Uniforms for sports teams must be worn when representing the school and are available to loan or buy.

Special Uniform Items available for purchase from the school

Information regarding the opportunity to purchase the following items from the school will be distributed to families throughout the year:

- Year 12 polo shirts and jumpers – to be worn by current Year 12 students only
- Special Interest Volleyball competition tops – to be worn by SIV students at competitions only
- Special Interest Music jacket – to be worn by SIM students on endorsed camps and excursions only
- House Captains’ polo shirts – to be worn by House Captains during special school events.

Footwear	Black, flat-soled, leather, lace-up school shoes or plain black leather sports shoes Brown leather school (not fashion) sandals with acceptable support and sturdy strap buckled around the ankle Note: sandals are NOT to be worn for practical subject. Boots are NOT to be worn.

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Request for Exemptions from the Uniform Policy and Dress Code

To seek an exemption from the prescribed uniform items above, please contact the relevant [Year Level Leader](#) who will consult with the Principal. Consideration will be given based on disability or additional needs, medical or health requirements, and/or religious or cultural requirements. Exemptions will be applied based on need rather than preference.
